

2022 CoWN Scholarship Information

Purpose – To recognize outstanding students that are continuing their education in any field of study to any college.

Eligibility – Student must have shown in 3 CoWN horse shows in the current calendar year. CoWN Winterfest Championship show will count as a required show, even though the show has not been held prior to application dead line. If the student doesn't show, and needs this show for eligibly the application will be pulled. Student can be a graduating senior in high school or a college freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in good academic standing.

Basis of Award – The selection of the scholarship recipient will be based upon the students GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4 point scale (must include transcripts), activities and CoWN involvement.

Award – Number and amount of scholarships to be determined by scholarship committee. Monies must be applied toward tuition or required educational materials. Scholarship award must be used for upcoming semester. Monies will be made payable to the school in the name of the student. Scholarship award winners will be announced at the year end awards banquet.

- 2. Copy of transcript
- 3. Recent photograph of yourself
- 4. Two letters of recommendation from non-family members.
