World Show Qualifying

A horse/rider must show during the calendar year (January-October) in the same class and division at least one time in order to qualify for that class/division. For the Open and L1 Open, qualification is on the horse. The horse must be shown in that class and division by any rider at least one time to qualify to compete at the World Show.

Qualifying will be verified through the SHTX or CoWN year end standings. Showing in breed classes such as AQHA or APHA does not count for qualifying.

In the unfortunate event a qualified horse/rider is unable to compete due to illness or lameness, horse substitutions will be considered with documentation on a case-by-case basis.

Collegiate divisions are NON-QUALIFYING.

Show Format

There will be 2 go-rounds of competition. The overall Stock Horse World Champions will be determined by adding points from each go-round. Riders must be entered in all 4 events to be eligible for all around awards; however, riders are not required to enter both go-rounds or all 4 classes.

Please pay attention to the schedule for each Go-Round. Some days are a mixture of Go-Round 1 and Go-Round 2

RV Reservations

RVs are reserved online through OpenStalls.com, at 7am. Show sponsors with priority stalling/RVs will be contacted mid-September for stalling/RV preferences.

Stalling

Opens October 4 at 7am in the SHTX Store. Reservations are due October 11. Reservations after 10/11 will be what is available.

Stalling is a flat fee with 2 arrival dates. Stalls are not available per night.

- Shavings \$10/bag. No outside shavings allowed.

Need to stay Sunday night? You can make arrangements with the SHTX office for a Sunday night stall.

To stall with friends, you must use the **EXACT SAME GROUP NAME** for all orders so the computer sorts the group name together.

Have a stallion? Designate that on your stall reservation.

Stalls are solid at the bottom and have bars across the top half of the stalls. Nearly all stalls are on concrete.

Stalling/RV Refunds

Cancellations must be received by October 11 to receive a refund. No stall/RV/shavings refunds are possible after October 11. Cancellations must be through the online refund form. No texts, phone calls or emails.

Any refunds for credit card transactions will retain 5% to offset the credit card fees.

Rest Assured Stall Pads (text Lisa @ 972-935-2779) has stall pads installed prior to your arrival if pre-ordered for \$110. The pads are new and you own them and can take them with you when you leave. They are not made of material for long. term, multi-show use.

Arrival Times

Stalls will be available Tuesday after 3pm. <u>Due to a large event the weekend prior</u>, no arrivals are allowed before Tuesday at 3pm.

Enter Gate 3 across from the football field.

Arenas are open for riding Tuesday afternoon, and before/after the show each day unless officials are working the ground. The Taylor Telecom Arena closes approx. 10pm, but will open early each morning. Other arenas are open overnight and will close approx 1 hour before the start of the show. Please follow warm up arena etiquette and be courteous at all times.

Trail courses will be set by Tuesday afternoon for practice. Courses will be open overnight and will close approx.. 1 hour before the start of the show.

Health Documents

All horses must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins. Out of state horses are required to have a Health Certificate within 30 days of travel to cross state lines per the Texas Animal Health Commission.

Entry, Changes, Scratches/Refunds



General Information

Entries Open September 16. The entry link is available on the SHTX Website or Horse Show Tracker. Deadline for entry is October 4, 2024.

World Show Go-Round late entries accepted until October 11 with a \$100 late fee. No entries will be accepted after October 11 for the World Show.

Results for each day will be final as of 10am the following day. SHTX strongly encourages exhibitors to check the score sheets. Score sheets will be posted on the wall asap after each class. We double check all addition in the office, but we're not perfect! Any errors or corrections MUST BE REPORTED IN PERSON TO THE OFFICE BY 10AM THE FOLLOWING DAY so that all awards can be finalized for the event.

Entry Fees

Entry Changes

All class changes must be made by October 11 so

classes can be drawn. The show schedule will be published prior to 10/11, so changes due to scheduling must be made by this time. Classes can not be entered at the show. Changes must be received through the online Scratch/Add Form. No texts, phone calls or emails.

Horse substitutions once the show starts (in the event of a documented lame horse, etc) will be considered on a case-by-case basis, but only the same horse/rider combination will count for overall World Show Awards.

Entry Scratches / Refund Policy

Entry Scratches by entry deadline, Oct. 4 = full refund

After October 4, cattle fees and office fees are not refundable.

Entry Scratches by 5pm Monday, Oct 21 = class fees refunded; cattle and office fees are retained. Entry Scratches after Monday, 10/21 are not refundable.

All entry scratches must be received IN PERSON AT THE SHOW or via the SCRATCH/ADD form. NO TEXTS or EMAILS PLEASE. "No-shows" will be automatically charged \$250 or office/cattle fees, whichever is greater.

Texas Triple Threat - TQHA Incentive

The Texas Triple Threat \$10,000 Incentive is designed to reward Texas horse owners and Texas riders who show Texas-bred American Quarter Horses. Riders must be all around eligible & enter both go-rounds.

Eligible riders must fill out the Texas Triple Threat Online Entry Form by October 22. Texas Triple Threat does not include SHTX Collegiate divisions.

Exhibitor must be a Texas resident and member of SHTX and TQHA by October 22, 2024 (TQHA memberships can be purchased online. Owner and Breeder (as listed on the horse's registration papers) must be a Texas resident. Registration papers verifying Texas residency must be uploaded with the TTT Entry form.

APHA Chrome Cash Incentive

Chrome Cash rewards APHA-registered horses for their accomplishments across all divisions at the Stock Horse World Show.

Eligible riders must fill out the Online Chrome Cash Entry Form by October 22 and pay the required \$25 entry fee. A copy of APHA registration papers must be uploaded with the Chrome Cash Entry Form, and the owner must be a current APHA member.

\$1,000 in added money from SHTX and \$500 in added money from APHA, plus 100% of the Chrome Cash entry fee will be paid out through the Chrome Cash Incentive. Riders must be all around eligible & enter both go-rounds.

Incentive Calculations

Scores of eligible riders for each incentive will be pooled together across all divisions and ranked for each class. Points will be assigned based on those rankings, and those with the most points will earn Incentive Money based on the SHTX payout schedule.

It is strictly forbidden for spectators, visitors or exhibitors to sell, post or give away photos taken inside competition areas at the Stock Horse World Show (aside from cell phone photo/video) unless obtained from the show photographer.

Collegiate Rules & Awards

Collegiate Schedule & Eligibility

Collegiate riders enter their respective collegiate division. <u>Collegiate Classes will be Friday, Saturday and Sunday.</u> Awards are presented for each Go-Round, as well as overall. Both team and individual collegiate awards will be presented at the Collegiate Awards Ceremony on Sunday afternoon, Oct 27.

Riders must meet collegiate eligibility guidelines per the National Intercollegiate Ranch and Stock Horse Association (NIRSHA) rule book. Team calculations are based on NIRSHA rules, including situations of point rider substitutions.

Qualification is not required in the collegiate division.

Collegiate riders are permitted to cross enter by entering SHTX "regular" divisions if they have shown in the regular divisions throughout the year and are vying for Year End Awards.

Those double entering must pay 2 entry fees. When possible, the runs will be concurrent, but not all will be. Consult the schedule & visit with the SHTX office about which classes are concurrent. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their concurrent score is documented on the results of both collegiate and regular divisions by 10am the morning after the event.

Collegiate teams can take advantage of partial week stalling. Stalls are not available per night.
